Support for Cocoa Farmers

Highlights

We are engaged in addressing challenges along our supply chain by directly supporting cocoa farmers in Côte d'Ivoire, Ghana, and Ecuador through the implementation of GAP and cocoa cultivation in consideration of climate change. Farmers and communities taking part in these programs receive a premium for their provided cocoa beans, leading to an increase in household income. These premiums are also paid out as compensation for any additional work required to meet the Group's standards or any third-party standards, which contrib-

utes to strengthening the supply chain. In 2021, we implemented support programs for 1,250 cocoa farmers* in Ghana.

* This figure refers to the 2020 to 2021 cocoa harvest cycle (October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2021).
