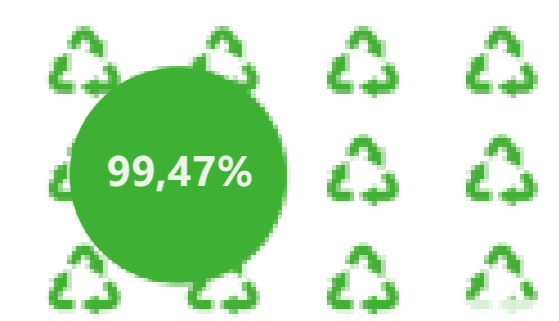
CO₂ emissions reduction (FY2021 result)



Water used reduction (FY2021 result)



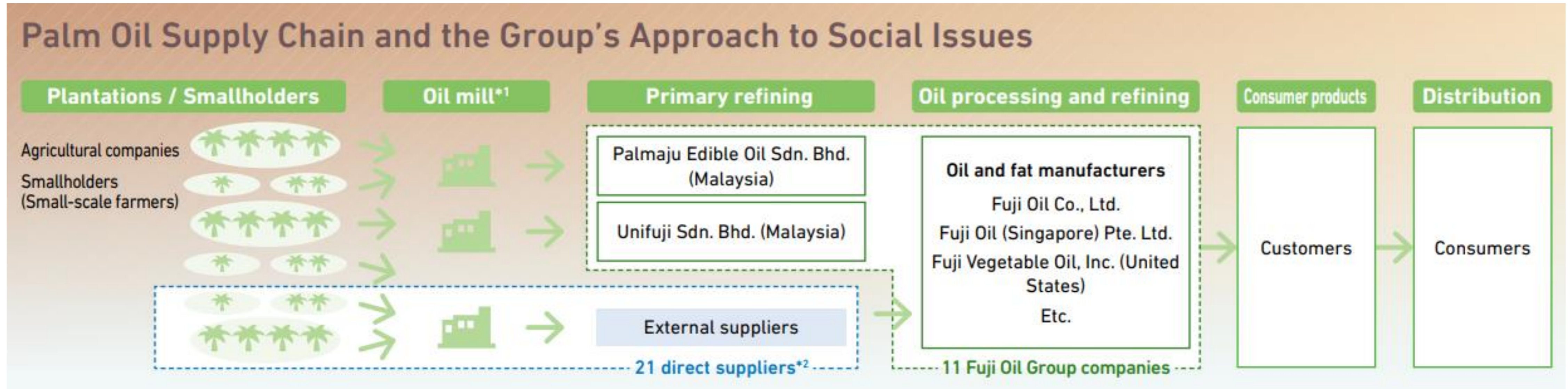

Monitoring of Deforestation within Supplier's Concessions

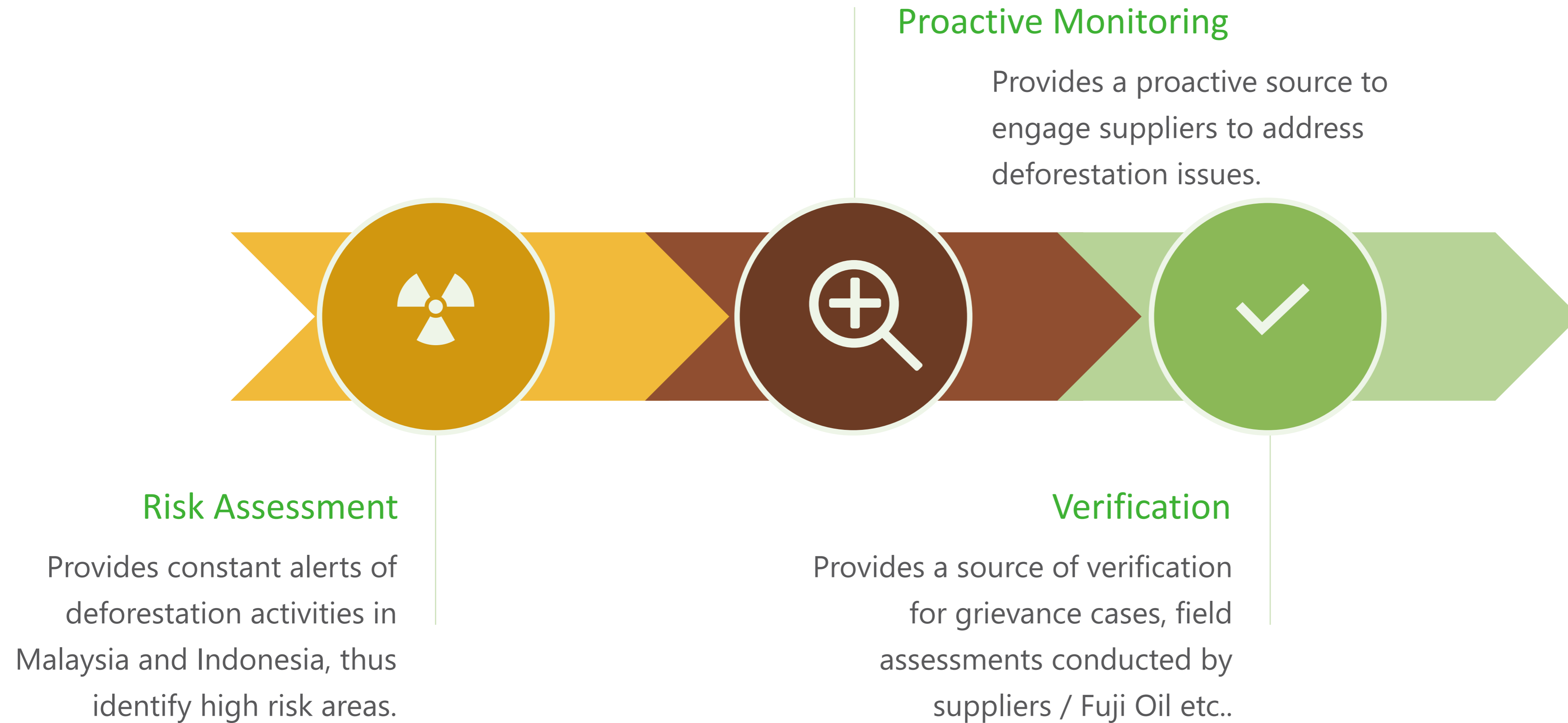


To monitor No Deforestation compliance in Fuji Oil's palm supply chain, Fuji Oil has partnered with an NPO to monitor suppliers' concessions using optical satellite imagery to capture deforestation activities.



- With satellite optical imagery, deforestation areas are clearly identified
- 2 monitoring reports provided monthly, and the accuracy of the monitoring scope depends on availability of Traceability to Plantation (TTP) data.
- TTP data accurately associates deforestation activities to Fuji Oil's supply chain

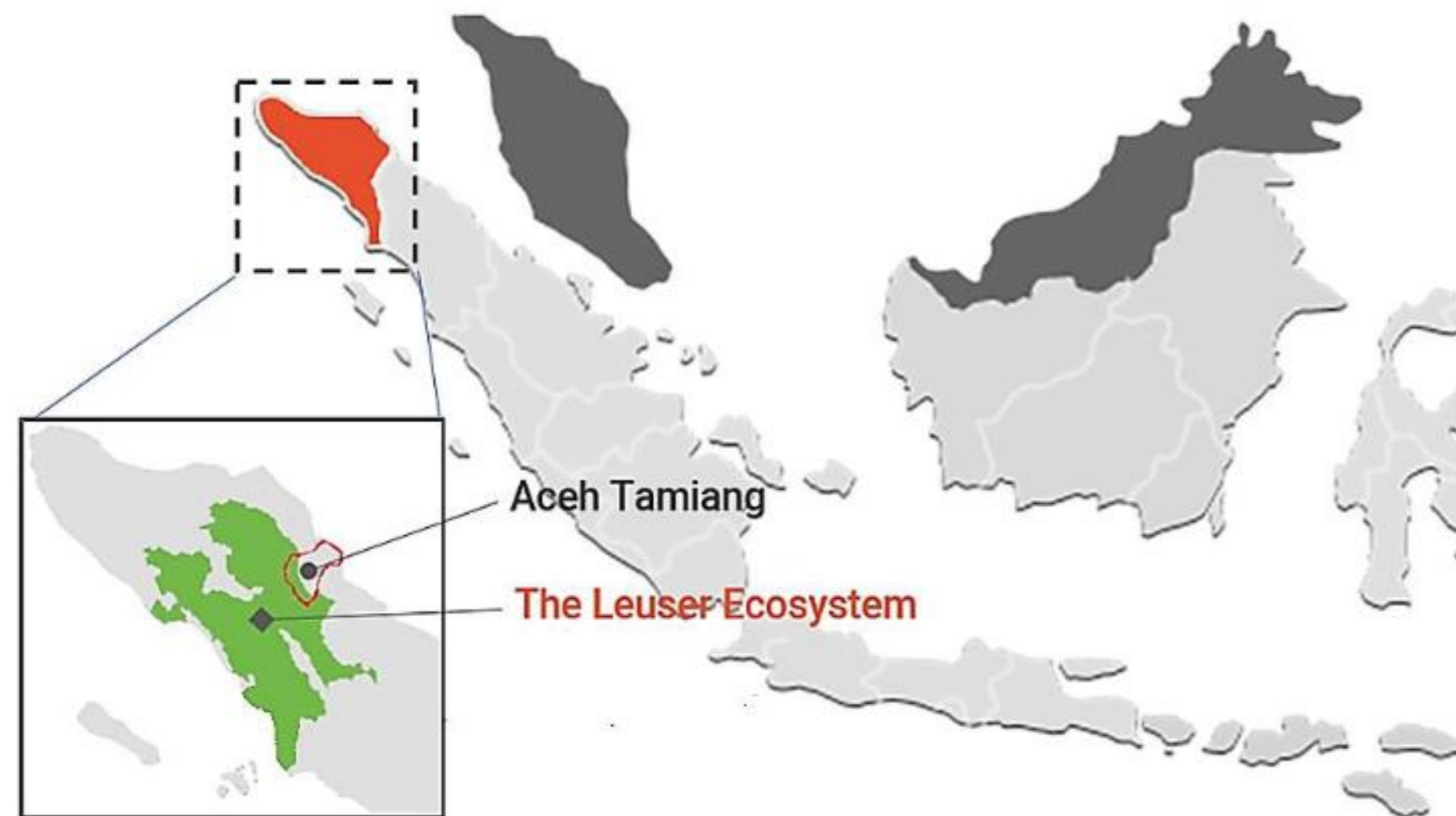

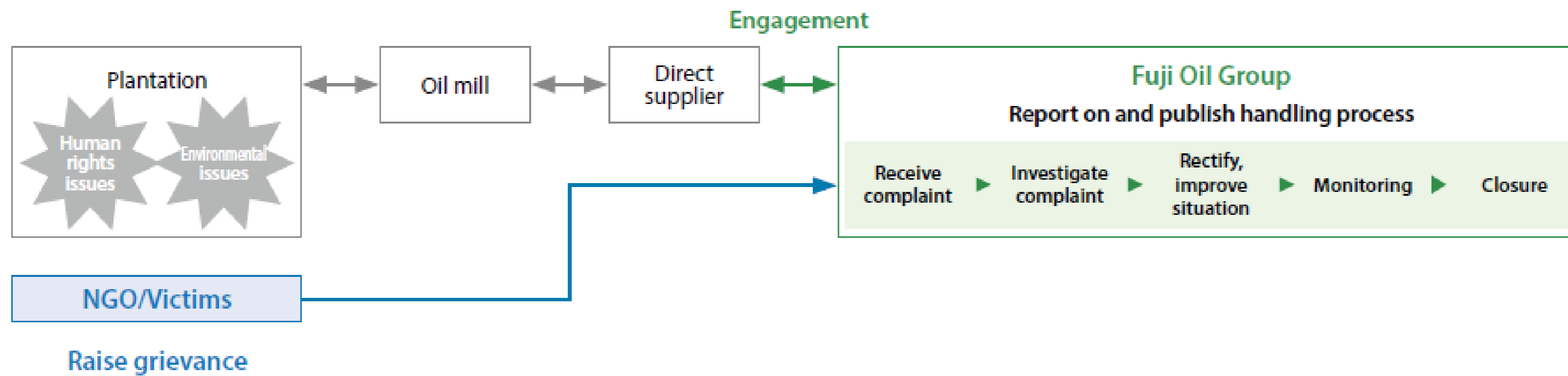

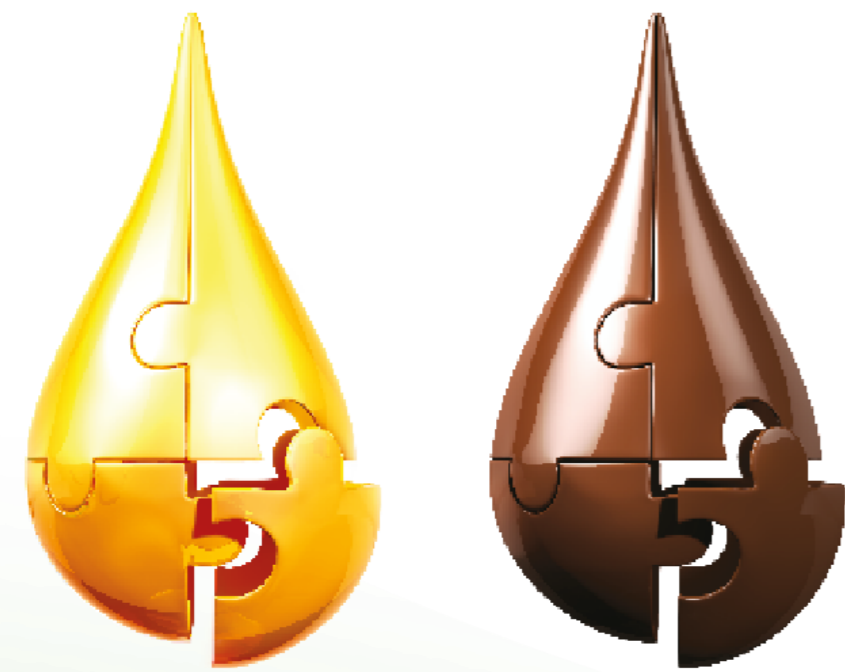
